USING THE THIRTY DAY CHALLENGE RSS SUBMISSION SERVICE

Day 10 is officially a cut-job day, so you can go through some of the things you were not able to do this week. However, in addition to that, you are going to learn a new service that Thirty Day Challenge (TDC) Team has just released.

This service will ultimately help get your blog or pages indexed and ranked a little quicker. It's an RSS submission service.

First, go to the <u>TDC Dashboard</u> and login using your user name and password.



If you scroll down a bit and look at the right hand side of the page, under the **Quick Links** section is a new tool called **TDC RSS Submitter**. Go ahead and click that.



The next page shows a form. You should fill that with the right information before submitting your blog's RSS feed.

Blog URL - The actual address of your blog.

Feed URL - The URL to the RSS feed.

Your Main Keyword Phrase – Main keyword for your micro-niche

Additional Tags – Any additional long tail keywords or phrases that you've found which relate to your blog so your blog may be indexed and ranked for those phrases.

A brief description – This is a short one-paragraph description of your blog.

Once you enter the information, over the next few days, it will go and contact a lot of RSS directories and feed submission services and it will add your blog to these services on your behalf.

It takes a lot of work out of you. This process takes about 35-40 minutes if you choose to do this manually. It saves quite a great amount of time and it is just a quick and simple form to fill in.

Let's continue with the Vintage Electric Guitar blog as an example.

First thing first, you need to copy the address of the blog, which is http://www.vintageelectricguitarblog.com/ and paste that in **Blog URL** field.

Next thing is the feed's URL. You can easily find this on the blog. Look at the screenshot below. **Right click** and choose **Copy Link Location**.



Depends on your template it may appear in different part of the blog. It may be on the left or right sidebar, or even at the top.

Paste the link to the **Feed URL** in the form.

You already know the main keyword here, which is Vintage Electric Guitar.

The additional tags need to be separated by commas, for example:

vintage acoustic guitar, vintage bass guitars, heritage guitars, vintage sunburst guitars, vintage les paul guitar

Next, the description doesn't have to be anything complicated, just like a sentence or a paragraph. You may want to put your main key phrase right near the beginning of the description.

A Vintage Electric Guitar blog for all fans and collectors of Vintage Guitars and equipment.

Once you have the complete information, all you need to do is click **Submit**.

As you can see, a message notifies you that your site has been added to the Thirty Day Challenge RSS Submitter.
